

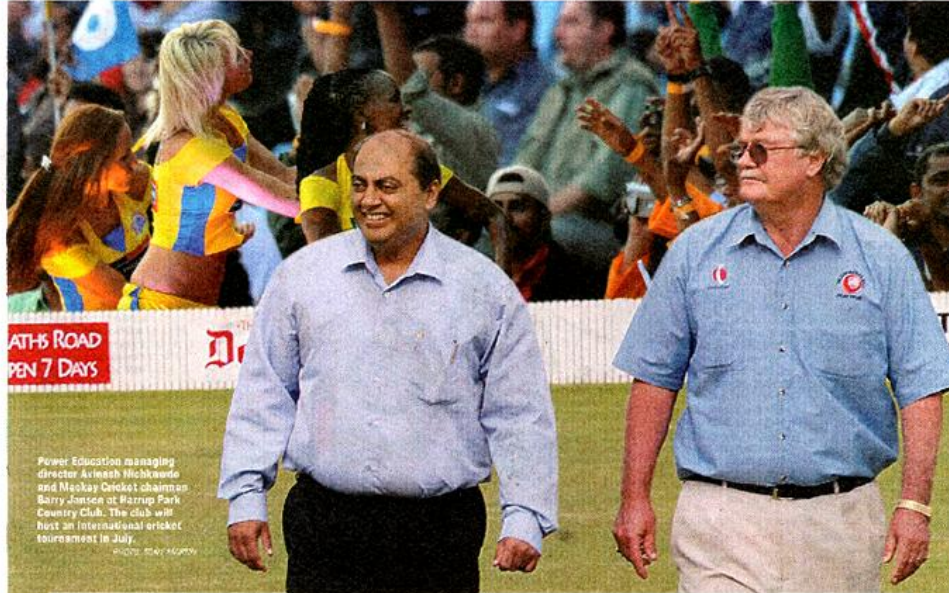

## TOURNAMENT SET TO BE A BIG HIT

### Unique cricket competition set to attract overseas teams

**CRICKET:** Mackay will become a global cricket destination in July when Harrup Park Country Club hosts a lucrative international tournament.

An initiative of sport education company Power Education, the tournament is set to include teams from India, New Zealand, North Queensland and possibly Sri Lanka.

The teams will be in Mackay from July 24 until August 3 and the highly anticipated

tournament will involve Twenty20 warm-up games as a prelude to the main 50-over series.

Mackay Cricket Association chairman Barry Jansen said there were also plans for two further competitions to be played following the tournament and a visit from a Delhi team prior to it.

"But basically our flagship event will be the large tournament," he said.

Jansen said the tournament would be a "unique" event unlike anything else in

Queensland or even Australia. The concept came about after recommendations from local cricketing identities Peter Philpott and Barry Knight, who are both on the advisory board to Power Education.

"They recommended that during winter this is the ideal place - it's the most beautiful part of the world, with the Great Barrier Reef, and the facilities at Harrup Park are unbelievable," Power Education managing director Arunesh Mohkawa said.

"We want to promote Harrup Park - and Mackay - everywhere."

The tournament will undoubtedly provide a sizeable boost for the local economy, with the event, plus the other planned competitions, spanning up to three months.

Jansen said aside from raising the profile of the Mackay community to a global audience, the tournament would also give local cricketers the chance to develop relationships with international teams and players.

The organisers are hoping the community gate behind the tournament and are looking for local support and sponsorship.

However, while the international tournament will bring an exciting new dimension to cricket at Harrup Park, local athletes can rest assured.


Harrup Park's general manager Brett Lea said the tournament would not affect the Mackay sports, such as soccer and AFL, that have existing
